### **Turning a thin walled Vessel**

April 2

This class is designed as a precursor for those that want it to the piercing and air brushing class offered in May. We go over the proper techniques to create a vessel with the thinness necessary for piercing with a high speed air tool. I'll show the use of a bowl gouge, termite tool, scrapers and other methods to obtain that 1/8" to 1/16" wall thickness.

### **Wood Carving on Turning**

April 30 and May 1

In this two day class I will be instructing the techniques to embellish your turned vessel, bowl or platter. With templates and some creativity I will help you design and layout a pattern and get you carving your way to new heights. If your turning is thin enough we can pierce through and carve for a unique open look. For those not wanting to pierce through we can carve into the surface for that bas relief effect. Each style can be just as creative and satisfying. So think about what you really enjoy in life and we'll try to put it in carving on your turning. 9:00am -4:00pm Cost is \$250.00

### **Piercing and Air Brushing**

May 21 and 22

This will be a two day class designed to bring out the creative person in you. On day one we'll go over the techniques of layout, piercing, texturing, and air brushing on a flat board. Then on day two we'll put those techniques to use on your thin walled vessel. We'll cover laying out panels and shapes. Deciding where to pierce and where to add texture, metal leaf and/or color will be a big part of the process. 9:00am -4:00pm Cost is \$250.00

### **Bowl turning class**

Ten week course

In this comprehensive ten week course we cover everything from tool selection and sharpening to cutting up green logs into rough out blanks. Then on to green turned bowls and finished turned bowls. Plates, platters, open vessels etc. are also covered. Each week we will do a new project that will build off what we learned the week before. The classes are 3hours once a week, either Tuesday morning 9:00 am – 12:00 noon, or Wednesday evening 6:00pm – 9:00pm. Dates of classes are dependant on student availability. Cost is \$550.00

### **Spindle turning class**

Ten week course

This is a great class to begin to learn woodturning. We start off with tools, sharpening, and woods. Each week will be a new project designed to utilize a new tool. We'll be turning things like weed pots, tool handles, honey drippers, coffee scoops, etc. I'll show you the ins and outs turning between centers and from a chuck. The classes are 3 hours once a week, either Tuesday morning 9:00 am – 12:00 noon, or Wednesday evening 6:00pm – 9:00pm. Dates of classes are dependant on student availability. Cost is \$550.00

### **Woodcarving with Chisel and Gouge**

Ten week course

This is a class designed for beginners. We start out with a bas relief carving of a flower then move on to an in the round carving of a sting ray, or Santa Clause. If time allows we'll get into kerbschnitzen, or what we call chip carving. This class also includes tool identification and sharpening. The classes are 3 hours once a week, either Tuesday morning 9:00 am – 12:00 noon, or Wednesday evening 6:00pm – 9:00pm. Dates of classes are dependant on student availability. Cost is \$550.00
